Interact clubs organize at least two service projects a year: one that benefits their community and one that encourages International connections. Interact Clubs are sponsored by Rotary Clubs as a program of Rotary International. As one of the most significant and fastest-growing programs of Rotary service, with more than 10,700 clubs in 109 countries and geographical areas, Interact has become a worldwide phenomenon. Almost 200,000 young people are involved in Interact.

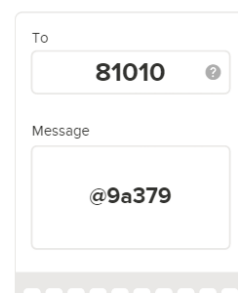
